The Huntsville Police Department, of the City of Huntsville, Alabama, will be applying for a United States Dept. of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$160,023.00. The City of Huntsville will be dividing the award amount 50/50 with the Madison County Commission.

This grant will fund the purchase of equipment upgrades to be used by the Huntsville Police Dept.
