

NOTICE OF  
PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing is called to be held before the City Council of the City of Huntsville in the Council Chambers at the Huntsville City Hall, 308 Fountain Circle, Huntsville, Alabama, on Monday, April 29, 2019, at 5:00 o'clock, p.m., for the purpose of allowing members of the public to express views, orally or in writing, as to the proposal by the Council to increase the rate of an ad valorem school tax levied in the said City, in order to provide for the uniformity and equalization of the rates of ad valorem taxation levied in the City for public school purposes, but without change to the aggregate rate of such taxes. The proposed action by the Council, which is subject to the approval of the Legislature of Alabama and a majority of the qualified electors of the said City voting at an election called for such purpose, will permit an increase in the rate at which the said ad valorem tax authorized by Amendment No. 8 to the Constitution and the laws of the State of Alabama is levied in the said City to a maximum rate which is equal to \$2.20 on each one hundred dollars (22.0 mills on each dollar) of assessed value (an increase of one dollar and fifty-five cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed value of taxable property, or 15.5 mills); the said increase being conditioned, in respect of any county in which the City is then situated, upon the corresponding reduction prior to or contemporaneously with levy of the said tax, as increased, of the rates of certain ad valorem school taxes heretofore levied in any part of the City therein for public school purposes; and the net proceeds of the tax, as increased, to be used for public school purposes. Members of the public are invited and encouraged to attend the public hearing.
